WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

Parents and students should bring the following information to complete the FAFSA worksheet:

- Student and parent (if providing parent information) **social security numbers** (most students **WILL** need to add parent information to the FAFSA);
- **Student driver's license** (if student has received one);
- **Alien Registration number if not a U.S. citizen;**
- **2009 federal tax information for the student and parent(s)**, if providing parent information. If the **2009 tax return** has not yet been filed, the FAFSA may still be submitted with estimated information, which can be updated at a later date;
- **Records of untaxed income**, such as Social Security benefits, welfare benefits, (e.g., TANF), and veterans benefits, for the student, and parents if providing parent information;
- **Information on savings, investments, business and farm assets** for the student and parents, if providing parent information.
